Constitution and By-Laws

For

The Orissa Society of the Americas, Inc.

Article I

Name - The name of the society shall be "Orissa Society of the Americas".

Article II

Objective - The objectives of the society shall be:

- (a) to form a non-political and non-profitable organization of all persons interested in Orissa,
- (b) to promote interest and activities in the understanding of the Orissan culture,
- (c) to facilitate exchange of information in the United States and Canada and vice-versa.

Article III

Power - The society shall have power to take all lawful action which is appropriate to the uchievements of its objectives.

Article IV

Membership - Membership shall be open to all persons interested in Orissa, as may be defined in the by-laws.

Annual dues shall be payable on October 1st of each year.

Article V

Organization -

- Section I: The ultimate authority of the society shall be vested in the membership and shall be expressed through the mail polls of the membership. The members shall choose by mail ballot the elective officers and shall amend by mail ballot the constitution and by-laws. Major policy proposals from the executive committee shall be submitted to the society by mail polls of the membership or through any other proposal that may be submitted to the society. and acted upon by the executive committee.
- Section II: The office bearers of the society shall be an elected President, a Vice-President and a Secretary-Treasurer. The executive committee of the OSA shall consist of the following:
 - 1. The President
 - 2. The Vice-President
 - 3. The Secretary-Treasurer.
 - 4. The Editor
 - 5. The immediate past President
 - 6. One Representative from the local chapter(s)
- Section III: The Terms and Method of Election:

 The President, the Vice President and the Secretary-Treasurer shall be elected for a term of two years. The Vice President shall be the running mate of the President. A vote for the

president shall mean a vote for his running mate. The president shall choose the Editor.

Section IV: Powers and Functions:

The President shall be the chief Executive officer of the society. The executive committee which is directly responsible to the members of the OSA, shall be installed in the Annual convention for a term of two years. The other office bearers also shalltake office during the Annual convention for a term of two years.

The President, in consultation with the Executive committee, shall present a detailed plan of activities including the budgetof the OSA, the membership drive, and the cultural activities of the OSA at the annual convention. In the event of inaction or negligence of duties by any member of the Executive committee, the President shall call re-election or renomination of such officer(s) within a period of two months.

If the President fails to perform his duties to the satisfaction of the members of the OSA, he shall be removed by a vote of no-confidence. This motion must be moved by a petition shigned by at least 10% of the total membership, as published in the OSA News Letter. The Secretary shall circulate this motion among the presidents of the local chapters who shall form a committee to investigate the allegations against the President. This committee shall appoint an election committee to conduct an opinion poll against the President and declare the findings within two months.

In case of the removal of the President, the Vice President shall assume the office of the President for the rest of the term and call for the election of the Vice President within two months.

The President shall be free to conduct his activities in consultation with the presidents of the local chapters. The presidents of the local chapters shall serve as a group of elders.

<u>Vice President</u>: The Vice President shall derive his duties from the President.

Secretary-Treasurer: The Secretary-Treasurer shall assume office along with the President and shall present a detailed budget for one year at the annual convention. He shall prepare the budget in consultation with the President of the OSA. The Secretary in cooperation with the Editor shall compile an annual list of members of the OSA who have and who have not paid their annual dues. Any expenditure exceeding \$100.00 must have the written approval of the President of the OSA. The office bearers of the OSA can be reimbursed reasonable mailing and telephone expenses up to \$10.00 and expenses beyond \$10.00 must have the written approval of the President of the OSA. After the expiration of his term or in case of his replacement, the Secretary-Treasurer shall take necessary steps to transfer the the accounts to his successor.

Editor: The Editor shall be responsible to bring out at least four quarterly publications of the News Letter. Seventy (70) percent of the space of each News Letter shall include the following:

1. Editor's Note, 2. President's Message, 3. Local Chapter Activity, 4. Orissa News, 5. Children, Youth and Women Section.

The remaining thirty(30) percent of the space of each News Letter

shall carry the news and other items as per the choice of the Editor.

For any clarification and controversaries concerning the News Letter, "Robert's Rules of Order" shall be consulted and take effect.

Transfer of Office: The outgoing office bearers shall hand over the OSA documents or papers connected to the society to the newly elected persons within 30 days after installation to the respective offices.

- Section V: Nominating Committee: A nominating committee shall be appointed by the Executive committee which shall make all arrangements for the nomination of all elective officers.
- Section VI: Meetings: The society shall promote conferences, study meetings, discussion meetings or other activities as circumstances make it possible.
- Section VII: Local Chapters: The society encourages the opening of local chapter(s) in different parts of USA and Canada with a minimum membership of ten (10).
- Ammendments Ammendment to the constitution may be proposed (a) by the executive committee or (b) by petition signed by 1.0% of the membership. All proposed sumendments shall be considered adopted if approved by a majority of those members returning ballots. Ammendments shall be effective from the beginning of the next term.

By-Laws of the Society

Membership dues

- (1) Membership shall be divided into the following classes:
 Patron: Persons who contribute \$200 or more to the society.

 Life Member: Persons who contribute \$100.00 to the society.

 Honorary Member: Persons selected to this scatus by the Executive Committee.

 Family Member: A family who pays the annual dues of \$15.00

 Single Member: A person who pays annual dues of \$5.00.

 Supporting Member: Persons or organization who contribute \$5.00 per year.

 Note Honorary and supporting members are not eligible for any elected
- (2) Dues may be changed with the approval of the executive committee.
- (3) The Fiscal Year of the society shall end on September 30th.

Publications

The periodical publications of the society shall be the News Letter and any other publications the executive committee may see fit to establish.

Miscellaneous:

No part of the earnings, if any, of the society shall inure to the benefit of any member, officer or private individual. In the event of dissolution of the society funds and/or assets on hand shall be distributed to such charitable organizations as have objectives similar to this society as the executive committee of the society by majority vote shall direct.

AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE ORISSA SOCIETY OF AMERICAS, INC.

ARTICLE-V, Section-2:

An additional student member shall be nominated by the President to the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE-V, Section-5:

The name of the Nominating Committee to be changed to the Election Committee. The Election Committee shall be appointed by the Executive Committee which shall make all arrangements for the Election of all elected members. In the first issue of the Newsletter of the election year nominations for various officers of the Orissa Society of Americas, Inc. will be solicited from the membership. The ballots shall be mailed out at least two months before the Annual Convention. The results of the election shall be announced by the Election Committee at the Convention. and subsequently published in the Newsletter. The new office bearers shall be installed at the Annual Convention.



OSA THROUGH THE YEARS

THE DRIVING SPIRIT

In September of 1958, when I was coming to the U.S.A., I had to stop for several days at Calcutta for Visa formalities. One day, I met a 'pan dokani' in Calcutta and found that he was an Oriya. As soon as he knew that I was also an Oriya and coming to the United States, he became very elated and invited about 20-25 Oriya friends, mostly laborers and plumbers to greet me in a party and then gave me a grand send-off at the Howrah Station. When I reached Bombay, a group of Oriyas, mostly students from Bombay Veterinary College, became my gracious hosts and spent much time and money to look after my comforts and saw me off at the airport by Air India. These Oriyas knew no more of me than the simple fact that I was an Oriya. The unsolicited help, outpouring sympathy and comradery these people bestowed upon me will be ever remembered by me and I am very proud of the strong spirit that binds us all together.

It is the same spirit, I strongly believe, that has propelled each and every one of you to have gathered here. It has cost you hundreds of dollars or even more. Many of you have travelled thousands of miles and gone through many a hardship to arrive here. You have not cared for these problems, just to see a few familiar faces, speak a few words of Oriya and only for one brief weekend. It is this feeling for the 'roots', the feeling of nostalgia, the feeling of excitment and electrification of the body and mind to hear an Odissi song or see an Odissi dance or even to hear the lines of an old drama written by Fakir Mohan. The feeling is the same as an Italian connoisseur gets when he goes to the opera, or a German gets when he hears Bach. That is Culture and that is called the 'roots'. We are really fortunate to be in this 'land of the free and home of the brave' where we can have the luxury of living comfortably and being free to cultivate our ethinic values and culture. Today, we are exceedingly happy to see such a large gathering of Oriyas, each of us happy, prosperous and contented. To reminisce the past of the Oriyas in the Americas, it is gratifying to note that really we have come a long way. Until about 1963, I did not find a single Oriya in New York area (Dr. A. Barman was there, but unknown to me at that time). One day, I went through almost the entire New York telephone directory to chance upon one J.M.Das, who happened to be the famous Chief Engineer, Jamini Mohan Das. He was visiting U.S.A. with 3 or 4 other Oriya engineers for a brief period. It was a great evening we spent together in my basement apartment in Queens - until I was almost thrown out by my land lady because of our loudness! But things have changed and we have increased our number in this continent (Don't feel too happy though - our group is still the smallest among the other Indian immigrants). After President Johnson liberalized immigration quotas in 1965, we began to see a little trickle of Oriya immigrants into this country I believe, now we should number about 700-1000 in the U.S.A. and Canada together. Although OSA was founded only in 1970 in Boston (almost simultaneously with the formation of OSANY in New York and 'Utkal Samaj' in Canada), we have done tremendous progress in our activities through these

years. Because of scattered nature of our membership, several local chapters have been formed and local activities have been rather prolific. First and foremost, we have established ourselves as respectable members of the community and mostly in good financial standing. Considering the way and the meager resources we came here with, this is no small achievement. Don't you remember, many of us came here with only \$8.00 ? Our members are now mostly professionals, doctors, engineers, scientists, professors etc... I would hazard a guess that most of our Oriya families would rank in upper 25-30% of the socio-economic strata of the American Society. For this, our people have worked hard, prepared ourselves academically and ofcourse, Lord Jagannath has been kind to us. We have helped ourselves and our family members here and back home, brought in as many members as legally possible. It is rumored that a few of us here brought in entire villages!!

LINK WITH OUR ROOTS

We have not closed our eyes to the cause of our fellow compatriots back home. We have raised funds for several charitable purposes in Orissa. To name a few - we sent about Rs.2,500. in 1972 for the Orissa Cyclone Relief through the Servants of India Society; in 1981-82, through the efforts of Jnana Ranjan Dash of California and Saradindu Misra of New York, the Oriyas living in North America raised more than Rs.50,000. which was sent for the flood victims of Orissa. Many individuals have donated sizable sums of money to their local schools, colleges and other charitable organizations in Orissa. In view of our lean membership, it is no small achievement! We have been doing this out of our yearning for the cause of the Oriyas. Whether our association does it, or some individuals of the group do it, we feel proud and happy for these activities. When one goes to the airport to receive an Oriya guest or a new comer, or the association receives an Oriya artist, it is the same spirit that guides both actions. Many of our members have been quite generous with their time and efforts in this regard and our association thanks them heartily. This is the real spirit we want to keep not only alive, but vigorcusly so, for the future. All this is possible because of you who have gathered here as much as the volunteers themselves - because you who have travelled thousands of miles and even spent hundreds and thousands of dollars to come here to demonstrate your spirit and indirectly to thank and appreciate the work of the volunteers. We sincerely extend our heartfelt thanks to you and all the volunteers who have made all the annual conventions, local functions and even this year's function a real success. The volunteers deserve our gratitude and thanks because that is their only remuneration!

COMMUNITY & CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

As a natural outgrowth of our strong linkage with our 'roots' and heritage, we have strived to maintain and expand our relationship with Orissa. We have received, entertained and felicitated many talented personalities in various spheres of activities that affect our lives and culture. We received the then Chief Minister, Mr. R.N.Singh Deo who visited the States as a State Guest in 1971. We received and felicitated in 1975, Mr. Satyapriya Mohanty, the then Speaker of the Orissa Assembly. We also received Mr. Rabi Ray, the then General Secretary of the Janata Party. We felicitated Dr. Sadasiv Misra, Vice Chancellor of the Utkal University; Dr. Banshidar Panda, the well-known industrialist of Orissa; and Dr. Sarat

Chandra Misra, the benovolent physician of Cuttack; Mr. Samarendra Kundu, the then Minister for External Affairs of India. Our group also sponsored in 1979, Dr. Minati Misra and Mr. Akshaya Mohanty who gave several performances of dance and music in the U.S.A. and in Canada - thanks to the efforts of Mr. Pratap Das, Dr. Rabi Patnaik, Dr. Amiya Patnaik, Mr. Saradindu Misra and Dr. Uma Ballav Mishra. Our group also jointly sponsored along with the Heart and Hand for Handicapped, Mr. Raghunath Panigrahi, Mrs. Sanjukta Panigrahi and party who gave several Odissi dance and music performances in USA and Canada in 1980. Thanks to the efforts of Mr. Saradindu Misra. Also through the efforts of Mr. Misra, we received the well-known musician of Orissa, Mr. Sikander Alam who presented several performances throughout USA and Canada. Our group also organized several Odissi dance performances by Ratilekha Dash, Mrs. Itishree Panda, Mrs. Chitralekha Patnaik and Miss Subrina Biswal at the U.S.Consulate, Hindu Temple, New Jersey Convention and IAA convention in New York City. Our group also presented several dance, drama and music programs by several local artists at various local chapters. Programs to encourage the youth to participate in and learn the rich cultural heritage of Orissa have been consistently included as an integral part of our functions both at local chapters as well as the annual conventions. The contribution of the Washington group in 1983 was spectacular in this regard. Not only they devoted a significant part of the program for youth participants, but also they revitalized the concept of camping of several hundred Oriya families and children for a long weekend giving a forum for the youth and families to enjoy a sort of 'Heritage Camp' for the Oriyas. We had annual celebrations of Kumar Utsav festival with great cultural activities for the young and old. We have celebrated for the first time Jagannath Ratha Jatra at the Hindu Temple in collaboration with the Jagannath Society of New York. For over the past year, we have started an Oriya School for our youngsters, the venue of which rotates, every two weeks, in the houses of the parents. Dr. Uma Ballav Mishra has been instrumental in running this school with the help of Mrs. Sulekha Das and Mr. Samar Bhuyan. Language is the genesis of culture. We are very grateful to the above individuals to have taken up such an important task. We sincerely hope that other volunteers will join them and expand the project in scope and depth. Dr. Uma Mishra has also brought many video movies of live programs on Oriya music and cultural performances from Orissa. These have proved very enriching to the community and have proved educational for the youth. We heartily thank him for his efforts.

OSA - A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION

We are thankful to Mr. Ladukesh Patnaik and Mr. Satyabrata Shaw for making OSA a non-profit organization approved by the I.R.S. This enables OSA to receive contributions which are tax deductible to the donors. This provision will encourage individuals with higher incomes to increase the amount of contribution without really 'paying' more. This is an important landmark in the history of our society. We sincerely hope that more contributors will consider this aspect while making their contributions.

OSA NEWSLETTER

The quarterly newsletter of OSA has been quite informative. It fosters a link among the far-flung membership and provides helpful information to the members. The contributions of the present editor, Mr. Jnana Ranjan Dash is gratefully acknowledged as also the efforts of the previous editors

of OSA. Many newsletters were also issued by local chapters that were well received as informative and lively. It is very important that such newsletters are continued.

OSA ACTIVITIES IN THE SOUTH

Dr. Pramode K. Patnaik of Huntsville, Alabama has made a solid contribution for the Oriyas by holding the fort in the South. Dr. Patnaik and his group have celebrated many functions regularly in the South and have also helped Oriya artists for various performances. Dr. Rabi Narayan Mahapatra, a former Professor of Physics at the City University of New York, at 'now a Professor at University of Maryland, has been recognized as one of the eminent scientists of international reputation. Dr. Brajendra Nath Misra is the Chairman and Director of the Surgical Training Program at Prince George's Hospital, University of Maryland. Our association is proud of these worthy sons of Orissa and extend our felicitations to them.

Dr. Srigopal Mohanty has for many years held an eminent position in Mathematics and Statistics at the McMaster University in Canada. Dr. Rabi Kanungo has been recognized as a reputed authority on Management at the McGill University in Canada. Dr. Kalpataru Kanungo of Bridgeport, Connecticut, a highly scholastic scientist, has established himself as an eminent biologist in the USA. Dr. Lalatendu Mansinha, a professor of Geophysics at Western Ontario University is an authority on the subject. Dr. Artabandhu Dash holds an eminent position in Mathematics at the University of Guelph. Dr. Jagannath Das, a professor at the University of Alberta, has authored a book in psychology. Numerous members of our group are employed as professors and scientists all over the United States and Canada, particularly in the academic areas. I am sure that there are many more eminent scientists and professonals I have not been able to recall who have uplifted our face in the USA and Canada in the academic world. We salute all of them in academia.

There are many others who have enriched our community activities apart from their individual excellences. Dr. Duryodhan Mangaraj, a renowned polymer chemist, presently at Battel Laboratories in Ohio, has

been one of our stalwarts in community affairs. A typically unassuming academician, he has been a source of help and inspiration to other Oriyas. Mr. Bimal K. Mohanty of IBM fame has been the founding president of the Jagannath Society of New York and helped the first Odissi dance program by Dr. Minati Mishra in New York. We are happy to wlcome him back from Europe to revitalize our cultural affairs.

We are grateful to Dr. Gouri Charan Das who was the founder President of the OSA for many years in its early days and held the community together during the initial struggling years. OSA owes a special debt of gratitude to a man without whose untiring efforts, we could not have seen the present successful convention. He is Mr. Manaranjan Pattanayak, the current OSANY President and Chairman of the Convention Committee. He has ably harnessed the energies of diverse talents of a large group of volunteers and artists. With his recent immigration into the USA from Canada, he has aptly cemented the bonds of two sister communities to make this convention a memorable one.

Dr. Kashinath Sahoo, Mr. Prafulla K. Padhi and Dr. Uma Shankar Paty have consistently contributed great efforts to various activities of our organization and we are highly grateful to them. Dr. Jagat Mohan Subudhi has contributed generously and lavishly entertained both local and visiting Oriyas from India and our association appreciates his efforts for the cause of the community.

We have rendered help to some Oriyas when they needed medical care. Through the help of Dr. Ramesh Raichoudhury and Dr. Biswanath Shaw, Mr. Banamali Sahu got medical care in USA. In perfect tradition of Lilabati and Khanna, famous Indian Mathematicians, our women have become great assets to our community here and proven that they are no less than men in various fields.

Spanning medicine to computer science, our soft-spoken and humble looking ladies have shown their worth and established themselves in various professional and scientific fields. To name a few - Mrs. Navaneeta

ORISSA SOCIETY OF THE AMERICAS - HOW IT STARTED

In January 1969, there were three Oriyas in Boston area: Dr. Jogeswar Rath, a young resident, Mrs. Saraswati Rao, a W.H.O. Fellow at Boston University and me. We used to spend a lot of time together and dreamt of the day when Oriyas would have an association in this country. By November of 1969 our number was increased to seven. Mrs. Rao had left for India, but Dr. and Mrs. Prasanta Patnaik of Harvard University, Bidyut Rath, a young engineer, Manmohan Subudhi, a graduate student at M.I.T. and Chandra Sekhar Mohanty, a graduate student at the University of Rhode Island have moved into the area.

On December 4, 1969, Sunday afternoon, during an after lunch discussion at the apartment of Dr. Prasanta Patnaik, Dr. Jogeswar Rath suggested that we form an association of Oriyas in the area. We had talked about this idea at times, but that was the first time it was proposed to the whole group. Everybody was very much enthusistic about this idea and an association named 'New England Utkal Samaj' was born. The association had three objectives, namely to establish social ties among Oriyas living in the U.S.A. and Canada, to publicize Orissan culture and literature in America, and to help bright students from Orissa to come here for higher studies. It was probably the first formal association of Oriyas outside India. The newspapers of Orissa were informed. It was only a few weeks after the publication of the news: communication between Orissa and New England Utkal Samaj was established; letters, enquiries and requests came flowing in.

Nagabhusan Senapati joined M.I.T. as a graduate student in February, 1970. A few months later Dr. Prasanta Patnaik left for England. Dr. Duryodhan Mangaraj and Rabi Patnaik joined University of Massachusetts in Amberst. They were coming to Boston or we were going to Amberst very frequently. During the Labor Day weekend in 1970, we went to Amberst in a large group. Dr. Birendra Patnaik was also passing through Amberst at the same time. There in Dr. Mangaraj's house during a discussion about Orissa and Oriyas, the idea of compiling a directory of Oriyas in the U.S.A. and Canada came up. Everybody was very much enthusistic about it and we started writing a list of known names and addresses. The same weekend we went to Hartford to visit Dr. Bhabagrahi Misra who was teaching at Hartford Seminary at that time. Bhabagrahi Babu probably knew more Oriyas in North America than anybody else and he added a lot of names and addresses to our list. There we discussed the formation of a larger society with broader objectives.

On our return to Boston, we sent letters to all Oriyas we knew in the U.S.A. and Canada about the directory and requesting everybody to send the names and addresses of other Oriyas they knew. There was a tremendous amount of cooperation and the compilation of the directory of Oriyas in the U.S.A. and Canada continued mainly with the efforts of Manmohan Subudhi and Nagabhusan Senapati.

In the meantime we decided to have a get together of Oriyas in North America to discuss about and formally start an organization of Oriyas.

On October 5, 1970 invitations were sent to all Oriyas whose addresses were available to attend the first convention of Orissans in Hosmer Auditorium of Hartford Seminary Foundation in Hartford on October 17, 1970. Fifty five Oriyas, mostly from New England, New York and Pennsylvania came to the get together. Many friends and acquanintances were meeting for the first time in many years. The ladies had prepared food for a nice dinner. There were a cultural program and a meeting where with the enthusistic approval of everybody, an organization of Oriyas in the U.S.A. and Canada named 'ORISSA SOCIETY OF THE AMERICAS' was inaugurated. Its objective and scope were discussed and the election office bearers was held by voice vote. I was named President, Dr. Amiya Patnaik, Vice President; Dr. Bhabagrahi Misra, Secretary; Nagabhusan Senapati, Treasurer and Dr. Krushna Mohan Das, Dr. Jogeswar Rath, Mrs. Sakuntala Mangaraj and Rabì Patnaik members of Executive Committee. It was decided to publish a quarterly news letter called 'Orissa Society News' or 'Utkal Samachar' giving news from Orissa and news about Oriyas in the U.S.A. and Canada. Dr. Bhabagrahi Misra became the editor of the news letter.

The first issue of the news letter was published on October 20, 1970. Many who could not attend the convention in Hartford telephoned or wrote letters to learn more about the Society. In those days the enthusiasm and interest which Oriyas and others connected with Orissa took in the Society were umbelievable. The letters which members wrote to me in those early days of the Society showed how much they cared for and loved the organization. Many members voluntarily contributed money to the Society and wouls send their membership dues and contributions.

In March 1971, the Executive Committee of the Society was reconstituted. Dr. Krushna Mohan Das became the First Vice President. Rabi Ray, Pramode Patnaik, Dr. Sitikantha Dash, Dr. Bijay Das, Dr. Surya Misra and Dr. Rabi Kanungo joined the Executive Committee as members. As the geographic distance between members were very large, it was decided to open local chapters. The local chapters would further the aims and objectives of the Orissa Society of the America in collaboration with the parent organization. All these amendments were incorporated in the constitution and bylaws of the Society which had been drafted by Bhabagrahi Babu and me immediately after the formation of the Society. New York was first to open a local chapter, followed by Boston, San Francisco Bay area, Toronto, Atlanta, Chicago and South Dakota. The first directory of Oriyas in the U.S.A. and Canada was mailed on June 18, 1971. On June 30, 1971 an application was filed with U.S.Treasury Department to grant Tax Exempt Nonprofit Organization status to Orissa Society of the Americas.

The second annual Convention of Orissa Society was held on July 3, 1971 in Cambria Heights, New York City. It was a large gathering with a lot of heated discussion. It was agreed that the officers and the members of the Executive Committee should continue for a second year. As Dr. Jogeswar Rath was leaving for India, Dr. SriGopal Mohanty was nominated as member of the Executive Committee. Dr. Bhabagrahi Misra requested to be relieved of his post as Editor of the Newsletter and I took over that responsibility. The Government of the United States granted Orissa Society of the Americas nonprofit tax exempt status as a social organization on September 30, 1971.

All this happened a long time ago. I would like to thank the organizers of the Fifteenth Annual Convention of OSA for giving me the opportunity to recollect the past events and to put them down on paper for those who were either too young to remember or too far away to have noticed them.



OSA: One Youth's View

The main purposes for the creation of OSA were to: establish a non-political, non-profit organization for Oriyas, promote interest and activities in the understanding of Oriya culture, and facilitate the exchange of information in the United States and Canada. Thus far, OSA has done remarkably well in achieving these objectives.

The Oriya conventions, camps, picnics, etc. have been very enjoyable. I have made many lasting friendships because of OSA and these functions. I enjoyed meeting new people in Washington and am eagerly looking forward to the New York convention. In the years ahead, a greater emphasis should be placed on social events. Perhaps, there should be more activities. Rather than people just talking, they should participate in sports events, etc. Members of OSANY probably had the most fun at the Labor Day camp when the fathers played their sons and daughters in volleyball. Activities as these encourage camaraderie and teamwork, reinforcing existing friendships and creating new ones. Also, functions just for youths would be very beneficial.

The OSA newsletter has not helped spread news from other chapters but has also presented literary pieces from children. The newsletter currently emphasizes the success of the chapters' functions. It might also be wise to give reasons for the success. The description of events which made one function successful might help other chapters' functions be just as successful.

The cultural programs are worthwhile. However, they might benefit from the inclusion of more children-oriented acts. This might include American songs or dances. Then, the kids would not be as bored with the programs. Also, the introduction of Western acts acts is important so that adults appreciate the culture their children are exposed to. Finally, if children see their parents make an effort to understand American culture, they might make a greater effort to understand Oriya culture.

The general body meetings have been important because of the influx of ideas. However, the meeting might be more effective if women and youths participate more. Youth participation can be increased by conducting the meetings in English. Although many understand Oriya, they are not as comfortable with it. Other youths do not understand Oriya at all. English is the only language which is used in everyday life, and its use in the general body meetings would benefit everyone.

The election of officers has proven to be a relatively sound system. However, as I understand it, people who do not pay their dues are permitted to vote. This is a questionable practice at best. Those who refrain from paying their dues show that their level of interest in OSA is minimal and should

not be permitted to vote.

The decision-making process on both the national and local level is basically solid, but it does have a few flaws. On the national level, the executive committee includes a member from each chapter. However, this leaves those who aren't in a chapter relatively powerless. There should be a few at-large positions among these people. Also, there is only one representative for each chapter. This suggests that the New York chapter and the Boston chapter are on the same level. However, the New York chapter has far more people. An equitable solution to this problem might the formation of a two-part committee, much like the United States Congress. One section could have equal representation for each chapter while the other section could have representation based on membership. Also, OSA might benefit if people with personal differences do not let them interfere in policy decisions. Everyone must work together for the common good.

The OSA expenses are purposeful. The Orissa Relief Fund is very well-intentioned. However, in the future, our contributions to such organizations should be carefully monitored and earmarked for specific purposes to prevent misunderstandings. Money for education is also well-spent. More might be spent to educate Oriya children here, teaching them the Oriya language, history, culture, etc.

OSA is a fine organization. With a few changes, it could be perfect. I have made a few suggestions, and I encourage other people my age to write to the newsletter with their opinions. A greater influx of views could insure the prosperity of OSA for a long time.

THE BEAUTY OF ORISSA

Prof. Jitendra N. Mohanty


It is almost forty years ago that I left Orissa, returning only for brief vacations. But everytime I return to Orissa, I would spend most of my time in my village on the banks of the river Brahmani, remote from the cities. The villages of Orissa are unspeakably beautiful, and despite the poverty that stares you on the face, life has still a simplicity that charms and captivates. I realised that when during the entire year of fifty-five, I accompanied Vinoba Bhave in his padayātrā through Orissa. Day after day, we crossed green, or yellow or grey rice fields, treaked along winding village paths, stopped in coconut groves and mango orchards, dipped in village ponds, rested under hospitable roofs..... The memories are endless and would not let you go. But what is it that makes that unspeakable beauty possible?


It is the simplicity of heart of the human beings, combined with a heightened sense of bauty that derives from a highly sophisticated and artistic culture. In cultures that have lost their roots, beautiful things survive in art galleries, or in the pompos collections of the wealthy few, or in the intellectual appreciations by the elité. The beauty of Orissa is still (luckily for us, but for how long?) dispersed amongst the masses of people, along desolate village paths, in the niches of humble cottages, or the doors of the dilapidated village temples, in the performances of a village operatic troupe or the recitals of the local pälä singer. Odissi songs and dances - now receiving recognition in the wider world - never ceased to lighten up life in the midst of abysmal poverty. How could all this survive so long in their original, natural habitat, without being fossilised in museums in the cities?

I think the endurance of Oriya culture is due in a large measure to the intricate manner in which it centers around the temple, the figure and rituals of Jagannath. Every other state in India has its own place of pilgrimage, where believers from all over India go. But in no other state, to my knowledge, there is this unique phenomenon: a temple, its figures and its rituals so totally determine the entire culture - from everyday life to higher order of literary, artistic and musical creations. Every village temple is a replica, in miniature, of the temple at Puri; in every family ritual, the "original" ritual is repeated, reenacted and relived. Songs praise His glory. The greatest of the poets dedicate their writings to Him. Paintings on the village walls recreate Him and His family.

What I want to emphasize is not that it is all religion, that people are all religious devotees of Jagannath. They may or may not be.





What I am saying is that the religion of Jagannath is a unique *cultural* phenomenon, which the poets, artists and musicians, great and small, famed and unknown alike, have drawn their themes from, and which, as a result, has escaped the confines of the temple or the *puja* room of our home, to reach the entire life. As a simple cultural phenomenon, this has no parallel. Oriya life has been beautified by it. Life has acquired a special meaning.


But the concept Jagannath also symbolises a deeper thuth, not surfacing in the culture at all times, but grasped, from time to time, by the more profound minds. Historically, the temple, and its deity, has attracted the greatest amongst India's spiritual leaders - Samkara and Sri Chaitanya, to name only two. How could two such diverse spirits be attracted to one and the same deity? Samkara was the greatest defender of the path of Knowldege, Chaitanya of the path of love. All Hindu religious cults have had their interest in Jagannath. But what is more remarkable, the deity is also regarded - by an ancient tradition - as embodying the Buddhist wisdom about emptiness (sūnyatā) of all things and compassion (karunā) for all. How can the same deity be recognised by, and an attraction for, Hindus and Buddhists alike? And yet it is not a pre-Buddhist, in fact, a pre-Aryan, god, originally worshipped by a šabara chieftan?

The fact is: whatever may be the actual history of the temple and its presiding deity, the cult of Jagannath bears testimony to layers of sedimentation (like geological stratifications) of religious interpretations. Jagannath is all of these, and yet none in particular. It is a figure of what cannot be figured. The idol, with its curious human-like and yet not quite human form, is an attempt - a failed attempt at that - to give form to what is formless. The stamp of failure makes it so attractive. You have to see beyond the form.

What religious and philosophical thought could not grasp, poetry, music, painting and sculptures celebrated, and have been celebrating through the centuries. This celebration has permeated every aspect of Oriya life, and makes it so unique.

In this far off land - beyond the seven seas and thirteen rivers - let us not fail to keep alive, deep within ourselves, the memory of the land from where we have come and of the culture which nourished our ancestors and, without our knowing it, makes us what we inescably are.

JITENDRA N. MOHANTY is a scholar in Orissa's culture and Oriya Philosophy. He was formerly a professor of philosophy at New School of Social Research in New York and is currently at the University of Oklahoma, Norman, OK.

Das Mohapatra, Satyabrata Mishra, Surya Mishra, Gautama Mohanty, Sumitra Padhi, Keshab Farhi and Promode Pathaik. Major proofreading and revisions have been carried out by Jhana Dash, Umaballava Misra and Manaranjan Pattanayak.

There is little doubt that in spite of our best efforts many errors and oversights remain, for which we ask for your patience and understanding. 
