Dear Friends:

We have selected "Camp Tanadoona" as the site for our Annual convention of the Orissa Society of the Americas for this year. This camp is located on Lake Minnewasha in Excelsior, Minnesota. A map is enclosed for your information and use. The address of the camp is 3300 Tanadoona Boulevard, Excelsior, Minnesota 55343. The telephone number is 612/474-8085.

The camp is reserved for July 2-3, 1982. We are requested to leave the camp grounds by 10:00 am, July 4. We will have our Executive body meeting and dinner Friday evening and a picnic, banquet, and convention activities on Saturday July 3, 1982.

As we plan to stay at the camp, all must come prepared for camp living. Beds are available, but you have to bring your own linen, pillow, sleeping bags, towels and flash lights. We hope this camp will be very attractive to everybody. We will have access to a private beach and boats will be available for our pleasure. However, no alcohol is permitted in the camp ground.

The cost of the camping including two days lodging and food is \$40.00 per family and \$25.00 per single for those registering prior to June 1, 1982. Those registering after June 1, 1982 or at the convention will pay an additional \$5.00.

Camp Tanadoona is close to the Chanhassen Dinner Theater, Valley Fair, Minnesota Zoological Gardens, Lake Minnetonka, and many other places of interest. July 4 and 5 are holidays. We hope you will like to spend this time in Minneapolis or if you have time, you should plan to make a trip to Mount Rushmore in South Dakota. If your tight schedule does not permit a longer stay in the midwest, you will have plenty of time to drive home.

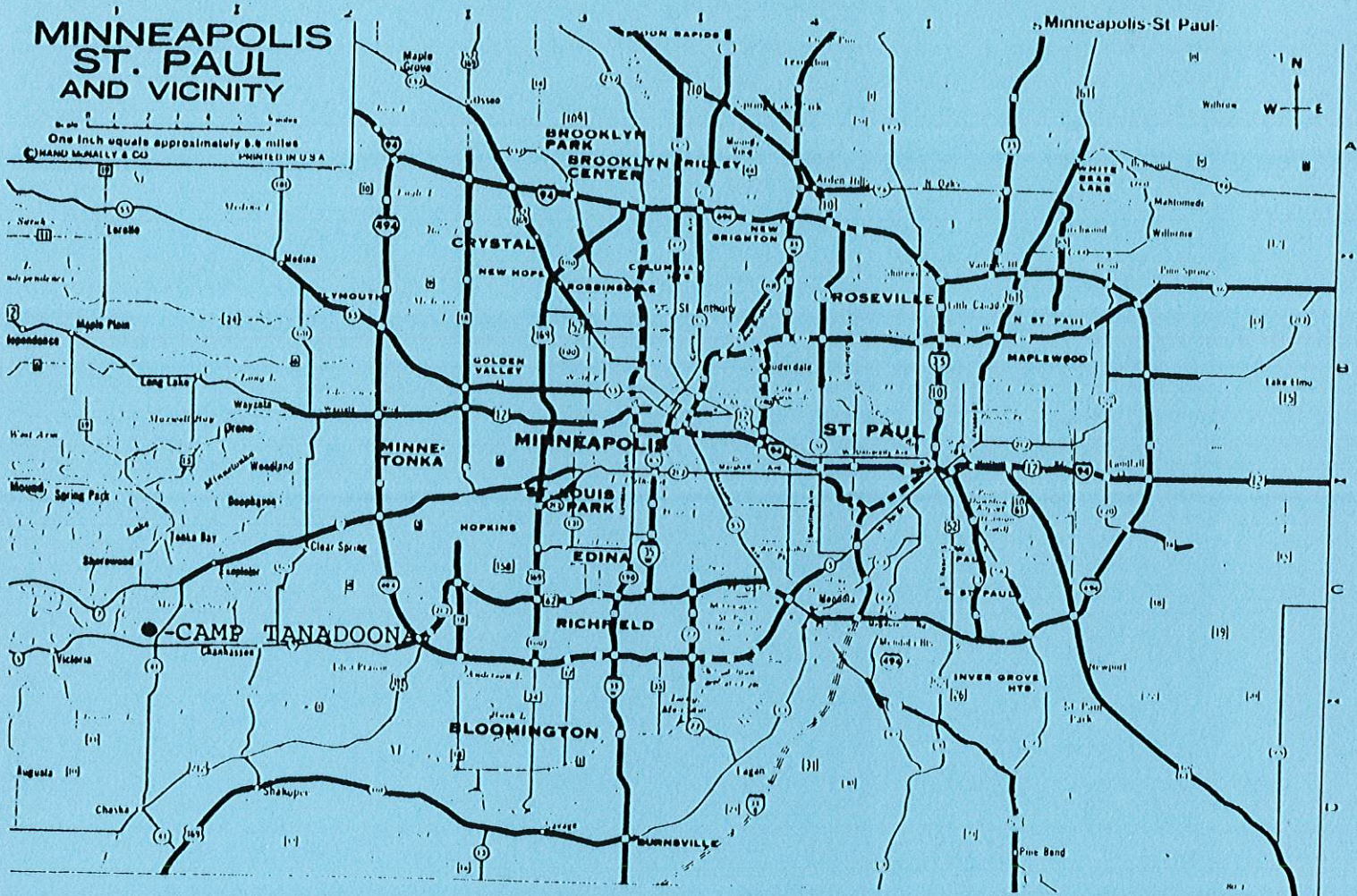
