#### THE FOURTH ADMUAL CONVENTION NEWS OF O.S.A.

The Annual Convention of OSA was held on July 6th 1974 in the University of Maryland Campus Chapel. Krushamohan Das presided over the convention. Dr. Sashi Bhusan Mohanty a faculty of the University delivered the welcoming address. The treasurer of the society Dr. Aminya K. Patnaik presented the accounts. During the course of his presentation Dr. Patnaik praised the contribution of Oriya Ladics during the previous convention by preparing delicious Oriya: dishes. He pointed out the inefficiency of the executive committee and resignation of the President of the society. The bleme was given on the geographical distribution of the Executive Committee members, ultimately prevented them to take any action on claost anything. Patnaik emphasised on the feet that, lack of achievements on the part of the OGA has created serious commern among some established members and which might alternately pose a threat to the existence of the society. He concluded his speech with an appeal to increase the membership fees and to assign local chapters the responsibility of collecting membership cuss.

Proxode K. The following members, that is, Dr. A. Patnaik, Mr. Samar Bhuyan, Mr. Promode K. Patnaik, Juana Das were elected to the committee along with Dr. Gouri C. Das as the Chairman.

He praised the democratic spirit of the members for their openness in discussing the problems.
