Notes

- **Introduction:** The BOG started with a brief welcome by the Secretary OSA. This was followed by brief introduction of New EC team and their individual background as well as Chapter Presidents' brief introduction.
- **Vision of OSA EC Team for 2019-2021:** The OSA President gave an overview of the Vision of the EC 2019-2021 that highlighted - OSA care, an initiative for providing senior care to the members and their families, Need for Women empowerment, Importance of Connecting to the Youth of OSA, and improve effectiveness of hotline service for people in need.

- **Convention Update:**

Vice President Anil Patnaik summarized the EC efforts to explore possible hosts for the 51st Convention.

- President Mrs. Kuku Das and Vice President Mr. Anil Patnaik, reached out to Austin, TX (OSA South West) Chapter members regarding hosting convention there. After a few deliberations with the community, the team regretted that they would not be able to host in short notice but expressed interest in hosting the OSA Convention 2022 onwards.
- However, in the meetings with OSA Southern chapter, after deliberations with Mrs. Kuku Das and Mr. Anil Patnaik, and their chapter members, Mrs. Nalini Patnaik (President, OSA Southern) informed that they are ready to host the convention at Nashville.

Mrs. Nalini Patnaik requested information as well as suggestions about funding and other financial matters. Many National Executives of OSA, both current and past assured all help needed in hosting the convention by Southern Chapter. Immediate Past President, Mr. Lalatendu Mohanty expressed his gratitude for Mrs. Patnaik's contributions to the Community, as well as appreciated her assistance towards library in Brahmapur, Odisha.

- **Website Standardization:** Mr. Utkal Nayak, OSA Treasurer, spoke about upcoming changes to website as well as proposed standardization of OSA website, that would make it easy for chapters to maintain chapter specific information available for easy access by members. He elaborated the next steps to implement this by –
 - Forming a committee of member volunteers to look after IT infrastructure, as well as content collaborators
 - Carrying forward the work started by previous EC team to create a new website that is much more responsive to increased demands for information exchange via website
 - Building a template that would enable chapter presidents to easily capture and distribute chapter specific information in standardized chapter pages under one website to provide consistency of content as well as reduce operational cost of managing multiple websites
 - Converging various independent IT infrastructure to under one roof to reduce redundant IT cost
